# That's a wrap

Lay your baby down to sleep in a snugly swaddle

**A**part from making baby feel warm and safe, swaddling assists with sleep by providing snug security and helping with their startle reflex (characterised by flailing arms and legs). Babies can stay in wraps for up to 12 months, but for the first three months they practically live in them. If you have a little Houdini, begin with their hands snugly wrapped against their body, and gradually release one arm at a time as the startle reflex dissipates at four to five months. **0030**

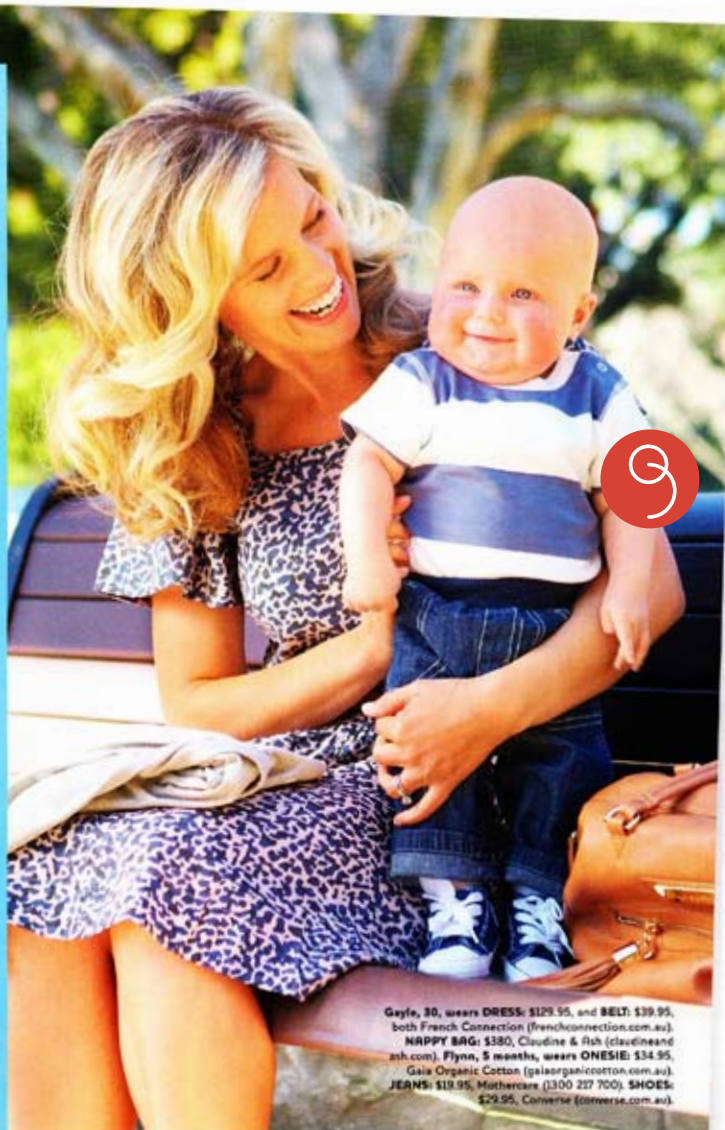

## In the car

Some babies love nothing more than the motion of a car and fall straight to sleep, while others will be vocal in their protests. Here are a few tips to "encourage" your bub to be an auto enthusiast.

- 1 Get used to driving with bub by taking short trips around the block when your baby is in a good mood. This will build up your confidence and your little one will get used to being in a car.
- 2 Have some calming music playing while you're in the car. White noise (think of that noise you get between radio stations, or audio of vacuum cleaners) can also work.
- 3 Removable window shades will shield bub from the sun.
- 4 Keep a box of special (and safe) toys in the car so there's always something interesting to play with.
- 5 Try giving them a dummy, as sucking on something may make them feel more content.
- 6 Keep a baby kit in the car filled with goodies you might need while you're on the road, including a change of clothes, toys if they are sick, nappies, wipes and plastic bags (keep these out of baby's reach).
- 7 If you're leaving the car, even just to fill up with petrol, take bub with you when you go to pay. Babies and young children are particularly sensitive to the effects of high temperatures and can quickly get stressed.

## Going walkabout

**Taking a stroll is a great way to get used to leaving the house with bub, but it helps to be prepared.**

- Plan for the weather by dressing baby appropriately and keeping them either covered with a blanket on a cool day or shielding them from the sun. Always take a beanie or sunhat!
- Avoid going out during periods of high heat or biting cold.
- Pack ahead of time and make sure you have enough to get you through your trip, such as nappies, bibs, wipes, change of clothes, feeding equipment, plus snacks and water for yourself.

- Plan ahead so you know where nearby facilities are, such as toilets, a microwave, baby change room, and most importantly, a decent coffee shop. It's a good idea to always carry cash, too.
- Breastfeeding in public is legal, but if you're uncomfortable, most major shopping centres have parent rooms where you can feed in private. Failing that, a good muslin cloth or breastfeeding cover can be used anywhere.
- Remember to get a handle on how your pram works long before you attempt to take your baby anywhere in it. You don't want to find yourself unable to collapse your pram while also having an unhappy baby to deal with. **029**
