## Miranda's all smiles flying in with Flynn

MIRANDA Kerr is not easily upstaged but yesterday the Aussie model sank into the background as her six-month-old son Flynn Bloom made his Australian debut.

Arriving at Sydney international airport after a 15-hour flight from Los Angeles, Kerr — in town as the face of retail giant David Jones — played second fiddle to her new offspring, who seemed deliriously happy to be visiting Sydney for the first time.

It's understood yesterday's arrival marked Kerr's first visit home since becoming a mum and wife to movie star Orlando Bloom, with her last visit back in February last year — shortly before her US wedding.

The 29-year-old model, who is set to begin a stint as a TV presenter on US fashion reality show *Project Runway All Stars*, is expected to remain in Sydney

will next Wednesday when she is expected to arrive in Australia at Sydney Airport early this week. Kerr didn't make a public appearance — instead posting motivational snippets on her personal blog, which she launched in 2008.

"Live your life to the fullest, start creating and living your dreams, anything is possible if you just believe," she wrote, later adding: "Have a fantastic week everyone. Lots of love, Miranda."

Soon after her arrival, the ex-medical local was seen heading to a series of fittings prior to Wednesday's show and was later spotted buying baby clothes in the Sydney CBD.

It's understood Kerr will remain in Australia for the month of August before returning to Los Angeles.
